

# Blues Point Navigation Tower Refurbishment Community Notification

February 2026

**Port Authority of NSW is undertaking a full refurbishment of the Blues Point Navigation Tower to facilitate its continued use as vessel navigation aid in Sydney Harbour.**

Blues Point Navigation Tower is an operational maritime aid to navigation located in Blues Point Reserve. The structure was originally installed at Millers Point in 1904 as part of a broader effort to improve navigational safety in Sydney Harbour following a series of vessel collisions. In 1977–78 the light structure was relocated to its current position at Blues Point.

## Work schedule

Works are expected to start week commencing 02 March 2026 and be completed by 10 April 2026, weather permitting.


## What work are we doing?

- Removal of the existing paint coating and repairing areas of damage and corrosion.
- Installing additional circumferential bracing near the base of the tower.
- Re-painting the tower with a heavy-duty coating to protect it from the elements.

## Construction hours

Work will take place during standard hours:

- Monday to Friday: 7:00am – 6:00pm
- Saturday (if required): 8:00am – 1:00pm
- No work on public holidays



## What to Expect

- A scaffold system will be installed around the tower to provide access to undertake the works and catch any waste material from the works including the old paint to be removed.
- A temporary contractor compound will be established for the secure storage of materials.
- Access around the headland will be closed during the works to ensure public and worker safety during critical activities. Alternate routes will be signposted during these closures.
