

# Berth Infrastructure Project

## Works compound and material storage at White Bay

**May 2026**

Port Authority of NSW is working to protect and future-proof the berth facilities for modern-day cruise ships at the Overseas Passenger Terminal (OPT) in Circular Quay. This work involves using a construction compound at White Bay for staging work storing and transferring some of the project materials.

The works include the delivery, handling and unloading of rock for use at the OPT, gathering materials for the project, and the unloading of dredged material for transfer to a land-based waste facility. We will need to use excavators, a crane and some tools to carry out this work safely.

### Works compound at White Bay

From Monday 4 May, we will be using a section of the wharf area at White Bay as a works compound for our berth infrastructure improvement project at the OPT. The compound will be used to store and gather materials for delivery and installation at the OPT. The materials will be stored within Port Authority's managed land next to our current Shore Power construction areas.

### Our work hours

We will work within our compound at White Bay during the day to receive dredged materials from the OPT for transfer to trucks for disposal at a land-based waste facility, and to prepare materials for transfer and installation at the OPT.

Our work hours will be **between 7am and 6pm Monday to Friday**, and **8am to 2pm on Saturdays**.

There will be no work within the compound carried out on Sundays or public holidays.

### Duration of works

Works within the compound area at White Bay will finish once the Berth Infrastructure Project at OPT is complete. We expect work to be complete in September 2026, weather permitting.

### Managing our impacts

We will be using excavators, a crane and other hand tools. There will be some noise from unloading rocks and filling rock bags in our work area.

Port Authority is committed to minimising disruption to the local community. We will do the following:

- We will work to ensure noise is managed within limits to minimise disruption
- Equipment will be switched off when not in use to minimise noise.
