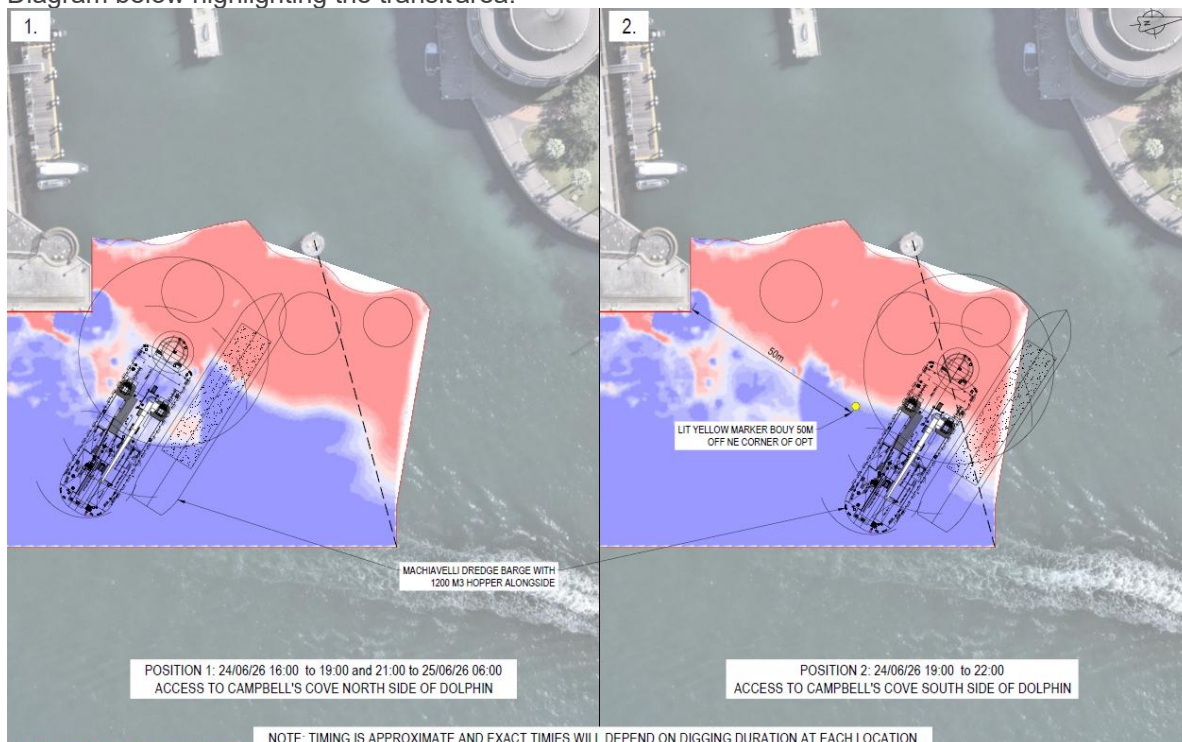
Overseas Passenger Terminal Dredging Works

Mariners are advised to navigate with caution within Campbells Cove due to the ongoing dredging works at the Overseas Passenger Terminal.

The dredging barge 'MACHIAVELLI' along with the supporting split hopper barge will impact the entry and exit for Campbells Cove between the hours of 1600 22/06/26 until 2300 24/06/26.

A yellow marker buoy will be installed 50 metres from the corner of the Overseas Passenger Terminal berth. To enter and exit Campbell's Cove, mariners will need to transit between the yellow marker buoy and the Overseas Passenger Terminal. There will be no access from the northern side of the dolphin.
