New Years Eve 2026 Buoy Positioning Trial

Mariners are advised that New Years Eve 2026 Buoy Positioning Trial will be conducted in Port Jackson, between Cockatoo Island and Bradleys Head. Trial is expected to be carried out between the hours 0900 Thursday 27th August 2026 until 0800 Friday 28th August 2026

Inflatable yellow buoys marked #42 to #50 (Figure 1) will be deployed from 0900 and #66 to #79 (Figure 1) will be deployed from 1000, on Thursday 27th August and recovered by 1400 on the same day.

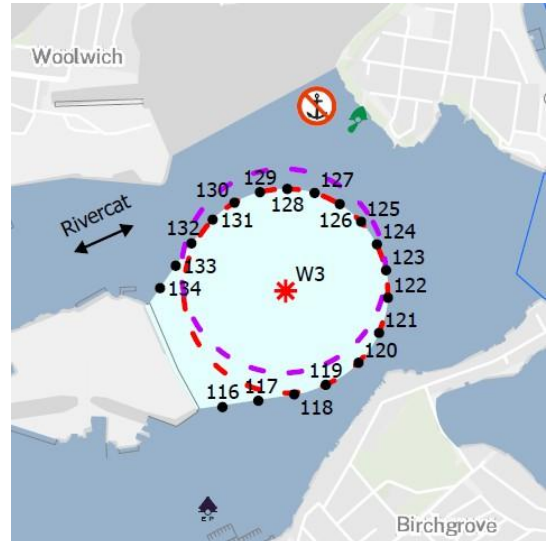


Figure 2. Cockatoo Island to Birchgrove.

Inflatable yellow lit buoys marked #116 to #133 (Figure 2) will be deployed from 1500 on Thursday 27th August and recovered by 0800 on Friday 28th August 2026.

A navigation warning will be broadcasted when buoys are in position during this period.
